



Fitzwilliam College, Cambridge will offer an ST Telemedia - Lee Kuan Yew Undergraduate Scholarship to a student who has received an offer to study on an undergraduate degree course at Fitzwilliam College commencing in October 2021. The Scholarship, which may be held for up to four years, will cover all tuition fees and a living and travel allowance for a student from Singapore from a financially disadvantaged background, or who has been affected by disability, bereavement or other challenging circumstances. There will be no bond attached.

The Scholarships, which will be awarded annually for the next four years, are funded by a generous donation from ST Telemedia to the Lee Kuan Yew Fitzwilliam Fund, established in 2016 in honour of Lee Kuan Yew, who studied Law at Fitzwilliam from 1947-1949 and was later an Honorary Fellow of the College.

Candidates who wish to be considered for admission to Fitzwilliam College, and thereafter (if successful in their academic application) to be considered for the ST Telemedia - Lee Kuan Yew Undergraduate Scholarship, must select Fitzwilliam as their preference college in their UCAS application. Candidates should indicate their wish to be considered for the ST Telemedia - Lee Kuan Yew Undergraduate Scholarship in the relevant section (F2.3) of the Cambridge Online Preliminary Application (COPA). If for any reason this is not possible they may contact the College directly to indicate their interest.

In January 2021, successful admissions candidates who have received an offer to study at Fitzwilliam College will be invited to complete a Scholarship application form, including a statement explaining their eligibility, and to submit a supporting reference (normally from their headteacher).

Having been successful in the standard admissions process, all candidates for the Scholarship will show strong academic ability and potential. The Scholarship itself will be awarded following an assessment of financial disadvantage and success in the face of adversity. Preference may be given to a candidate from a school in Singapore from which historically fewer students have graduated to the University of Cambridge. Preference may also be given to students undertaking study in Computer Science, Economics, Engineering, History and Politics, Human, Social and Political Sciences, Law or Mathematics.

Candidates will be informed of the outcome of their application in April 2021.
