For the Attention of the University Draftsman

At a Special Meeting on 10 October 2018, the College resolved to seek to make the following changes to the Statutes:

**1. Amend STATUTE VIII: Of the Tenure of the Mastership**

2. The Master shall hold the Mastership for a term of ten years, or until the date of retirement as provided in Section 1 of Statute XI, whichever is the shorter.

*to read*

2. The Master shall hold the Mastership for a term of **seven years, with the possibility of a further three years subject to the agreement of the Governing Body.**

**2. Amend STATUTE XI: Of the Retirement or Resignation of the Master**

1. The date of retirement of the Master shall be the thirtieth day of September next after he or she has attained the age of sixty-seven years; or, if the Master's birthday is on the thirtieth day of September, not later than the day on which he or she attains that age.

*to read*

1. The date of retirement of the Master shall **normally be the thirtieth day of September.**

**3. Amend STATUTE XIII: Of Fellowships in Class A**

5. The number of Fellowships in Class A shall be fixed from time to time by the Governing Body by a vote in which two-thirds of their whole number concur, save that except by consent of the Visitor there shall not be fewer than ten.

*to read*

5. The **maximum** number of Fellowships in Class A **may** be fixed from time to time by the Governing Body by a vote in which two-thirds of their whole number concur, save that except by consent of the Visitor there shall not be fewer than ten.
