Awards from the Fund may be made to any Junior Member of the College with the exception of those in the final year of their course.

The number and value of Sailbridge Special Project Awards made shall be determined by an awarding panel according to the numbers and quality of the proposals. Awards are not normally intended to cover the full costs of a project; where appropriate, applicants should demonstrate that they have applied for complementary funding from other sources.

Those who receive an award are required to provide a written report on the purpose and outcome of their project, which will be forwarded to the donor by the end of October each year.
