

EXCELECT RESEARCH AWARDS

The Excelect Research Awards were established in 2014 by Dr Kouros Saeb-Parsy, who matriculated at Fitzwilliam College in 1993, qualified as a medical doctor, gained a PhD in Neuroscience in 2001, and was elected to a Fellowship in 2003. He was the MCR President in 1998/1999.

Eligibility:

Pre-Clinical or Clinical students studying human or veterinary medicine at Fitzwilliam College, to support scientific research activities.

Award:

Up to two awards, to the value of £150 each, may be made to separate deserving candidates by the Tutorial Committee after joint consideration by the Directors of Studies in Pre-clinical Medical and Veterinary Medicine, Clinical Veterinary Medicine and Clinical Medicine.

Examples:

Research activities to be supported include, but will not be limited to, enabling students to attend and present their research findings at scientific meetings, and contributing to the personal expenses incurred during the conduct of a period of research outside their course requirements.

Note: It is not intended that award will support standard or elective attachments or activities that form a routine part of the medical or veterinary courses.

- **Deadline:** 1st June
- **Requirement:** to submit a short report within 6 weeks of completion
